Bud Bear

Handmade from recycled animal fur material donated by the CCT costume department, this one-of-a-kind bear was created as a memorable keepsake. This item is not intended as a child's toy due to the age and fragility of the fur.

'Bud', named after one of our organization's founding fathers, Bud Abbott, is made of silky soft beaver fur with a tilted hat that is slit on one side for the ear to poke through. The child-sized bow tie, white collar and cuffs, and buttons are custom fit to make up the rest of its costume.

Estimated value: \$500

Hare Bear

Handmade from recycled animal fur material donated by the CCT costume department, this one-of-a-kind bear was created as a memorable keepsake. This item is not intended as a child's toy due to the age and fragility of the fur.

'Hare-Bear', named after life-time member Harriet Pollock, is made of downy soft Coney rabbit fur. The name acknowledges her loyal dedication with the added connection to the words 'hare and rabbit'. The hat, slit for both ears, came from CCT's costume collection. The dress was once a theatre production's costume made smaller to fit the bear.

Estimated value: \$500

The Director Chairs

Two bamboo Director's chairs were embellished with the 50/60 logo printed on the fabric of each chair's back.

Each chair is a separate prize.

Estimated value: \$50 each
